DEFINITIONS:	A quilt is three layers of fabric quilted together.
Number of Entries	Limit three entries per person. Use a separate form for each entry. No entries will be accepted without a CURRENT Entry Form. No tied pieces please.
Photos	One photo of each entry and a total of ONE photo of yourself. no larger than 4" x 6". Please send both photos with Entry Form. Put your name and name of quilt on the back of all photos.
Large Quilts	Due to lack of space only TWO large Quilts (over 75 inches wide) per applicant will be accepted. Remember, our largest quilt rack is 108" wide. Anything larger will not hang smoothly.
Design Source	Due to copyright laws you must , if possible, give credit to the designer, name of pattern, book, and/or other source.
Artist Statement	Please describe your entry in 35 words or less on the reverse side of the Entry Form: technique, fabric, inspiration and anything you want to share about your quilt. This information will be printed on the information card along with a copy of your photo you enclose. You have spent a great deal of time in making this entry, so please take the time to tell your story.
Deadline	NO ENTRY FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER DEC. 1, 2015 ***NO EXCEPTIONS***
	Please be sure your entries are clean, smoke free and free of loose threads and hair.
Quilt Sales	No quilt sales will be allowed from the show floor.
Judging Catagory	Final decisions will be made by the Quilt Acquisitions Committee

Quilt Top Categories

- Pieced** Piecing predominates over other techniques . The quilt must be more than 90% pieced.
- Appliqué/Hand** Hand appliqué predominates over other techniques. The quilt must be more than 75% hand appliqué. The applique must be the focal point.
- Appliqué/Machine** Machine appliqué predominates over other techniques. The quilt must be more than 75% machine appliqué. The applique must be the focal point.
- Mixed** A combination of piecing, appliqué and/or other techniques.
- Innovative/Art** Entry is an art piece using your original design based on experiences, surroundings and ideas. May include innovative techniques.
- Miniatures** Quilt is 15” x 15” or less with a miniature design. It must appear as a full size quilt, but in a much smaller scale. It is not a single block with borders.
- Embroidery/Hand** Quilt is at least 75% hand embroidered and is the focal point.
- Embroidery/Machine** Quilt is at least 75% machine embroidered and is the focal point.
- Group** Quilt top has been constructed by more than one person, not including a hired quilter. (i.e.,: Friendship quilts, block exchange, online exchange)

Quilting Categories

- Hand** Completely quilted by hand.
- Edge to Edge/
Pantograph** Quilting is achieved with a single design/pattern across the quilt. A separate quilted border is acceptable. Not computer assisted.
- Free Motion/
Custom** Quilting/pattern is designed by the quilter. Must be at least 90% free motion quilted. Domestic Sewing Machine or Long Arm Machine Not computer assisted.
- Computer Assisted/
Custom** Quilting/pattern is quilted with a computer assisted machine. Must be at least 75% computer assisted.

AGREEMENT AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR DISPLAYING QUILTS

Please read before completing and signing entry form

The Valley Quilters are sponsoring this show for the pleasure of quilters and quilt lovers all over Southern California. We invite you to enter your quilt in our show, February 12 & 13, 2016. **ALL ENTRY FORMS must be received by December 1, 2015.** We request machine and hand quilted items only. No tied quilts. We reserve the right to refuse any quilts that we consider to be in poor taste or inappropriate for our show. You will be notified if your Entry is not accepted. Please be sure to keep a copy of your entry form.

THE OWNER OF THE QUILT AGREES TO:

- Hand sew on all quilts 75" or wider a 5" sleeve below the upper back edge so a rod for hanging can be inserted.
- Smaller quilts will be carefully pinned to a drape. Please be sure the sleeve is secure. Attach your own personal label to the lower back of your quilt.

Include a photo of each entry and one photo of yourself. (no larger than 4" x 6") It will be added to the quilt entry information card that is displayed on the quilt.

PICK UP:

All entries must be picked up between 4:30 & 5:30 p.m. on Saturday, February 13, 2016 (after the show). They will be handed out on a first come, first served basis. If you have a problem, call Mary Myers or Jacquie Buchanan.

Quilts will not be released without the receipt you were given on Wednesday. Please make sure you have a receipt for each item. No member or quilt owner will be allowed to remove his/her quilt from the display racks.

The Quilt Acquisitions Committee will remove all quilts. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
