## Opportunity Quilt

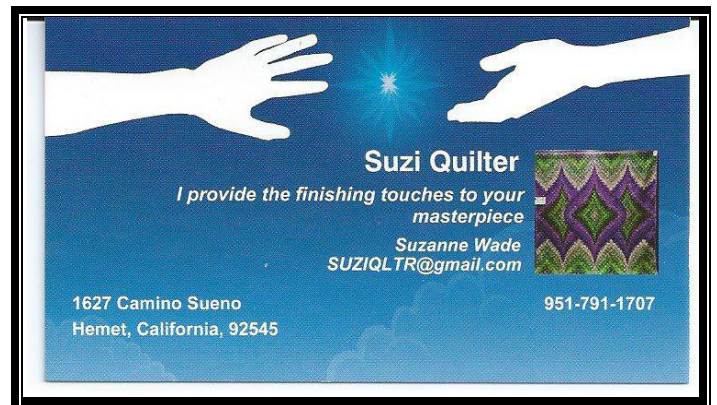

5. At the end of the year a participant's name will be drawn for the remaining fat quarters.


