AGREEMENT AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR DISPLAYING QUILTS

Please read before completing and signing entry form.

The Valley Quilters Guild is sponsoring this show for the pleasure of quilters and quilt lovers all over Southern California. We invite you to enter your quilt in our show, February 7 & 8, 2020. **ALL ENTRY FORMS must be received by December 1, 2019.** We request machine and hand quilted items only. **No tied quilts.** We reserve the right to refuse any quilts that we consider to be in poor taste or inappropriate for our show. **We cannot accept quilts that have been entered in a national quilt show.** You will be notified if your Entry is not accepted. Please be sure to keep a copy of your entry form.

THE OWNER OF THE QUILT AGREES TO:

Hand sew a 4 inch or larger hanging sleeve on ALL quilts large and small. Please be sure the sleeve is secure. Attach your own personal label to the lower back of your quilt

HAND DELIVERY

Delivery of the quilt is the responsibility of the Owner. All items for display must be hand delivered to:

Please contact Linda at the above numbers if a quilt you have entered will not be in the show or if you have questions.

Include a **photo of each entry and one photo of yourself** (no larger than 4" x 6"). The photo of yourself will be added to the quilt entry information card that is displayed on the quilt. The photo of your entry is used to place quilts on the show floor.

PICK UP

All entries must be picked up between **4:30 & 5:30 p.m. on Saturday, February 8, 2020** after the show). They will be handed out on a first come, first served basis. If you have a problem, call Linda Card.

Quilts will not be released without the receipt you were given on Wednesday. Please make sure you have a receipt for each item. No member or quilt owner will be allowed to remove his/her quilt from the display racks.

The Quilt Acquisitions Committee will remove all quilts. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

DEFINITIONS:	A quilt is three layers of fabric quilted together.
Number of Entries	Limit is three entries per person. Use a separate form for each entry. No entries will be accepted without a CURRENT Entry Form. Sorry, NO TIED QUILTS, PLEASE.
Photos	One photo of each entry and a total of ONE photo of yourself no larger than 4" x 6". Please send both photos with Entry Form. Put your name and name of your quilt on the back of all photos.
Large Quilts	Due to lack of space only TWO large Quilts (over 60 inches wide) per applicant will be accepted. Remember, our largest quilt rack is 120" wide. Anything larger will not hang smoothly.
Design Source	Due to copyright laws you must give credit to the designer, name of pattern, book, and/or other source if known.
Artist Statement	This is the story of your quilt in 35 words or less; it must be written on the reverse side of your Entry Form . Where are you from? Why did you choose this particular pattern? How long did it take from start to finish? Include as many interesting facts, problems, and/or triumphs as room will allow. Visitors love these tidbits. This information will appear with your picture on the card attached to your quilt. It is very important!
Deadline	NO ENTRY FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER DEC. 1, 2019 ***NO EXCEPTIONS*** Please be sure your entries are clean, smoke free and free of loose threads and hair.
Quilt Sales	No quilt sales will be allowed from the show floor.
Judging Category	Final decisions will be made by the Quilt Acquisitions Committee.

Quilt Top Categories

- Pieced** Piecing dominates over other techniques. The quilt must be more than 90% pieced.
- Appliqué/Hand** Hand appliqué dominates over other techniques. The quilt must be more than 75% hand appliqué. The appliqué must be the focal point.
- Appliqué/Machine** Machine appliqué dominates over other techniques. The quilt must be more than 75% machine appliqué. The appliqué must be the focal point.
- Mixed** A combination of piecing, appliqué and/or other techniques.
- Innovative/Art** Entry is an art piece using your original design based on experiences, surroundings and ideas. May include innovative techniques.
- Miniatures** Quilt is 24" x 24" or less with a miniature design. It must appear as a full size quilt, but on a much smaller scale. It is not a single block with borders.
- Embroidery/Hand** Quilt is at least 75% hand embroidered and this is the focal point.
- Embroidery/Machine** Quilt is at least 75% machine embroidered and this is the focal point.
- Group** Quilt top has been constructed by more than one person, not including a hired quilter (i.e. friendship quilts, block exchange, online exchange).

Quilting Categories

- Hand** Completely quilted by hand.
- Edge to Edge/ Pantograph** Quilting is achieved with a single design/pattern across the quilt. A separate quilted border is acceptable. Not computer assisted.
- Domestic Machine** Quilting/pattern is designed by the quilter using a Domestic Sewing Machine.
- Free Motion/ Custom** Quilting/pattern is designed by the quilter. Must be at least 90% free motion quilted using Long Arm Machine. Not computer assisted.
- Computer Assisted/Custom** Quilting/pattern/pantograph is quilted with a computer assisted machine.
