Attached you will find an application for floor booth space for the Valley Quilters Guild 2025 Annual Guild Show. If you wish to apply, please complete the application and return via Email or US mail at the address below.

Please submit your application as soon as possible as all vendor applications for floor booth space will be at reviewed and selections made in the order the applications are received. Space assignments will be at the discretion of the Show Committee.

#### **BOOTH SPACES AVAILABLE**

Booth space is 12 feet deep and are available at;

#### **BOOTH RENTAL FEE**

The booth rental fee is due **October 1, 2024**, however can be paid any time.

There will be a \$25.00 charge for cancellations before January 1, 2025.

NO refunds will be made after January 1, 2025.

#### **WAVIER OF LIABILITY**

Wavier of Liability forms - We must have a Wavier form for **EACH PERSON** who will be working in your booth, prior to the show date. This is a requirement of the facility!

#### **DUE DATE SUMMARY**

Applications are due immediately to reserve floor space for your booth.

Booth rental fee AND Waver of Liability forms(s), are due by October 1, 2024.

#### **QUILT SHOW SET UP**

Booths may be set up:

Thursday, February 7th, from no sooner than 1:00pm until 6:00pm, when the gym will close and/or Friday, February 8th from 8:00am to 9:00am.

YOUR booth MUST be totally set up by 9:00am Friday, February 8th.

#### In setting up your booth:

- ✓ <u>Valley Quilters Guild and Valley-Wide Recreation cannot provide manpower or equipment to set up</u> your space.
- ✓ You must stay within your assigned space, **including walls and supports**, a height requirement may be imposed.
- ✓ **Nothing** may be attached to the walls. If you need wall space, please let us know and we will attempt to accommodate your request.
- ✓ Windows may NOT be covered due to the possibility of power interruptions.
- ✓ Tables must be covered
