Attached you will find an application for floor booth space for the Valley Quilters Guild 2026 Annual Guild Show. If you wish to apply, please complete the application and return via Email or US mail at the address below.

Please submit your application as soon as possible as all vendor applications for floor booth space will be reviewed and selections made in the order the applications are received. Space assignments will be at the discretion of the Show Committee.

BOOTH SPACES AVAILABLE

Booth space is 12 feet deep and are available at; 6' by 12' at \$75.00 10' x 12' at \$100.00 12' x 12' at 150.00 18'x 12' at 225.00 24'x 12' at \$300.00

BOOTH RENTAL FEE

The booth rental fee can be paid at any time <u>Booth rental fee due no later than October 1, 2025</u> There will be a \$25.00 charge for cancellations before January 1, 2026. NO refunds will be made after January 1, 2026.

WAVIER OF LIABILITY

Wavier of Liability forms - We must have a Wavier form for **EACH PERSON** who will be working in your booth, <u>prior to the show date</u>. This is a requirement of the facility!

QUILT SHOW SET UP

Booths may be set up:

Thursday, February 13th, from <u>no sooner than 1:00pm</u> until 6:00pm, when the gym will close and/or Friday, February 14th from 8:00am to 9:00am.

YOUR booth <u>MUST</u> be totally set up by 9:00am Friday, February 13th.

In setting up your booth:

- ✓ <u>Valley Quilters Guild and Valley-Wide Recreation cannot provide manpower or equipment to set up</u> your space.
- ✓ You must stay within your assigned space, including walls and supports, a height requirement may be imposed.
- ✓ Nothing may be attached to the walls. If you need wall space, please let us know and we will attempt to accommodate your request.
- ✓ Windows may NOT be covered due to the possibility of power interruptions.
- ✓ Tables must be covered

In consideration for being permitted by the Valley Quilters Guild to participate in the above activity, I hereby wave, release and discharge any and all claims for damages for personal injury, death, or property damage which I may have, or which may hereafter accrue to me, as a result of participation in said activity. This release is intended to discharge in advance the above organization (its officers, employees, members, volunteers and agents) from any and all liability arising out of, or connected in any way with my participation in said activity, even though that liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness of the persons or entities mentioned above. It is understood that this activity involves an element of risk and danger of accidents and knowing those risks, I hereby assume those risks. It is further agreed that this waver, release and assumption of risk is to be binding on my heirs and assigns.
